Police Team to focus on Princes Gardens

A number of burglaries and attempted burglaries have been reported on our Estate this year, with several on Princes Gardens. While the crime rate remains low in our area, this was understandably causing concern to residents.

Members of the Residents Association committee attend regular meetings with the Hanger Hill Police Safer Neighbourhood team to help agree the priorities for policing in the local area. This autumn the local Police have agreed to provide a more visible police presence. Residents who have been victims of crime or who are near neighbours will have a visit from a local police officer for advice and support.

Please continue to report any concerning activity via 101 or online through the Metropolitan Police website <u>www.met.police.uk</u>. Having accurate reports of what's happening helps the Residents Association to push for the action that's needed.

Flats Solar Update and solar discount for Houses

Hanger Hill Garden Estate Limited (Flats Management Board) has won funding from the Community Energy Fund to explore the possibility of solar panels on Flats buildings. Flats residents will receive a letter soon with more details, and an invitation to a meeting in November.

But houses should not be left out! The project team are negotiating a 10% discount for houses on the Estate with the local renewable energy company who are currently undertaking work, and will confirm this once discussions have been held with the appropriate Council Planning and Conservation teams.
