SERVICE ROADS: Please leave clear for Council bin collections. Rubbish left on service roads that is not in a wheelie bin won't be taken away by Ealing Council. Houses residents can apply for a skip permit via www.hhgera.com/service-roads.



Solar Panels for Flats- the start of a long project!

There are a number of Government schemes offering funding for the installation of Community Energy Schemes. Working with the Flats Management Board, Flats residents are hoping to benefit from this and install solar panelling on the flat roofs at the back of the blocks.

We've already had assessments from two specialists who have confirmed the roofs are suitable, and that solar energy could meet the energy needed for the communal lighting and then be shared between the Flats in each block.

We are aware there have been a lot of thefts of parcels over the last few months. Please make sure the shared Flat doors are closed properly. Look out for your neighbours' parcels.
