Dear Resident.

As you may be aware in recent months a number of burglaries, attempted beak-ins and general anti-social behavior has been taking place within the Tudor Gardens / Princes Gardens area and Queens Drive. A contributing factor to this activity has been gates being left unlocked by residents, leading to opportunist or planned criminal activity. It is clear that the area is being targeted and as a result it is imperative to target harden the area. This starts with everyone being responsible for making sure the gate is locked at all times. Also consider implementing doorbell cameras and alarm systems if possible. Do not leave valuables on display which could attract criminals to your property. Over the coming weeks the Hanger Hill Safer Neighborhoods team will be addressing the issue further as a priority on the ward. Target hardening of your own property is your choice however, leaving the gate unlocked is negligent and leaves not only you but also your neighbors at risk of being a victim to crime. If the gate remains intermittently unlocked, we may have to consider alternative measures. Thank you for your cooperation.
